Promote computer literacy & technology assisted learning in villages through provision of infrastructure. c. Promote digital classrooms & e-education amongst needy. d. Aid construction of schools, collages, education centres & facilities including separate toilets for boys & girls and provision of drinking water. e. Contributing regular expenses of charitable educational institutions, f. Providing uniforms, books, stationery, computer etc. to deserving students g. Extend scholarships/fellowships to deserving students.

Promoting gender equality, empowering women, setting up homes and hostels for women and orphans; setting up old age homes, day care centres and such other facilities for senior citizens and measures for reducing inequalities faced by socially and economically backward groups – VII(iii)	<p>a. Give assistance for safe drinking water in villages and remote areas.</p> <p>b. Contribute for foods and other assistance to deserving poor families.</p> <p>c. Aid programs and initiatives, which are aimed at creating employment opportunities for the underprivileged.</p> <p>d. Contribute for welfare of victims of natural calamities.</p> <p>e.
